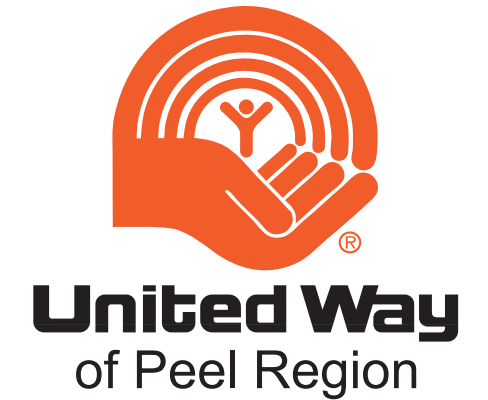


# United we can.
