Fast Facts

- Canadian youth are taking on roles as consumers earlier than ever before
- Youth who are homeless or at risk of homelessness are often excluded from mainstream financial institutions because they feel intimidated or unwelcome
- Youth with multiple barriers can sometimes be distrustful of organizations, financial institutions, and adults that appear to be knowledge keepers
- Lack of financial literacy is a barrier to post-secondary education
- More than 50% of people are one paycheck from a financial crisis
